Our Programming



Poultry Multiplication Initiative (PMI)

Since 2017, the WPF has provided financial investment and technical guidance to partner companies to produce and distribute over 115 million day-old chicks to more than 2.7 million households, in 8 countries. Funding from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and the Qatar Fund for International Development helped de-risk each investment, ultimately building self-sustaining value chains.

While all PMI countries to date have taken place in Africa, the WPF is actively exploring opportunities to expand the model to new regions.

Five Goals of PMI

- **1. Increased poultry productivity** by using low input dual purpose breeds versus the local indigenous birds
- 2. Increased household income
- 3. Improved household nutrition, particularly for children
- 4. Empowerment of women and youth
- **5. Rigorously track and measure impact** through real time data collection and analysis

Training Support

WPF develops targeted training programs for poultry producers, extension agents, veterinarians, farm managers, and other poultry actors based on needs. Programs range from one-day seminars to multi-year activities depending on location and funding, with past projects spanning Asia, Africa, and the Caribbean.

WPF continually adds to its extensive toolbox of open source resources including videos, checklists, worksheets, and manuals covering topics ranging from hatchery management, chick brooding, poultry housing, biosecurity, financial management, water and feed management, and vaccination. The latest development includes a mobile application to guide farmers when self-mixing feed.
